Western Heritage Art Project

Gold Buckle Champion's 1st annual Western Heritage Art Project will end this year with the judging during the Snake River Stampede's 100th year celebration in downtown Nampa.

Snake River Stampede and the Nampa Chamber have endorsed this project for its western heritage preservation by providing our youth with horses to decorate for their 100th Year Snake River Stampede Community Celebration Festival, to be auctioned in May for our youth program.

In the 1800's every large ranch held a rodeo or a cutting and invited the entire community out to be involved. With this came the original community networking celebration where everyone shared their wares, which we will experience in full force this July in downtown Nampa. The art project finalists, along with the artists who inspired them, will be on display downtown at Nampa's new public library with a youth demonstration rodeo in the square before the Stampede.

All the businesses and individuals of Nampa are encouraged to show their support by placing a decorated horse out in front of their business to show the strength of our community. These are not limited to businesses and everyone is encouraged to participate. Gold Buckle Champion is willing to custom decorate these horses for each business for a donation to our "Legends in the Making" program, which rewards our youth for doing positive things in their community.

The project with the horses for the Snake River Stampede Community Festival will run concurrently with our Western Heritage Art Project. We are proposing a competition of the best decorated horses for a Teacher's room makeover. A wood horse will be provided for any class that would like to participate. All the horses will be presented by May 15th for a judging. The top 3 Teachers who have inspired the imagination in the children will be award a class room make over. Three make over prizes are valued at \$500 - \$300 - \$200.

All horses will be auctioned/sold and the proceeds will go back to Gold Buckle Champion to fund this project and projects like "Legends in the Making"
