This publication is distributed by the Press Tribune to all of its subscribers, Sunday March 16th. The 16 page tab contains stories and information about all the events that go on during the ICHA Futurity & Aged Event, March 19-23, 2014. Selected prose will be published in the same tableau. Gold Buckle Champion is a non-profit organization whose mission is to further the education of equine health and safety while preserving our western heritage and history by means of promoting equine events incorporating the youth and community.



WHO MAY ENTER: Any middle school or high school student in Nampa, Caldwell and Kuna.

WHAT MAY BE ENTERED

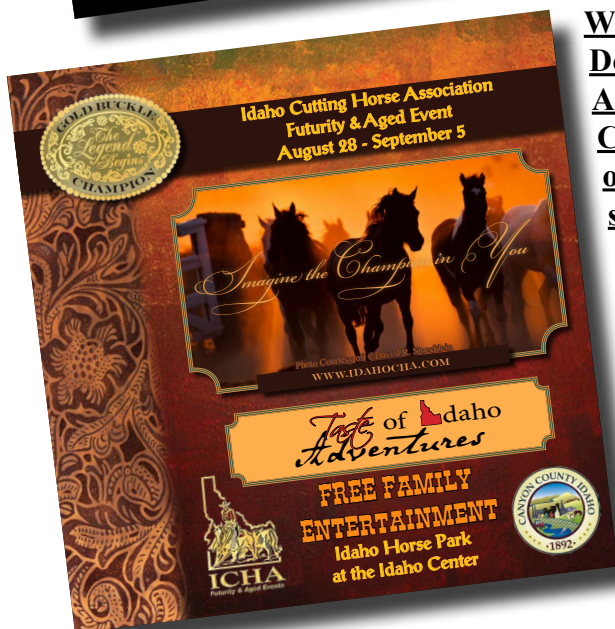
Artwork: Provide color images of the artwork for jury purposes. Provide copies of any prose in an electronic format as well as a printed format

Topic/subject matter: the art and/or prose (a written story, poetry, etc) is to depict Idaho's Western heritage. Artists can submit 2D or 3D works in any medium.

HOW MANY MAY BE ENTERED

Artists are limited to **5 submissions**.

SUBMISSION FEE: FREE



Winning entries will be displayed at Peterson Stampede Dodge in March prior to the Idaho Cutting Horse Association Futurity at the Idaho Horse Park in Nampa. Chosen winning artworks will also be auctioned off during the Futurity. Proceeds will be used for scholarship funds.

Awards, in the form of scholarships/prizes, will be given to the top 3 winning art selections and top 3 prose selections.

___ **1. ENTRY FORM** – COMPLETE BY PRINTING LEGIBLY & ADD SIGNATURE.

___ **2. DIGITAL FILE** – for pictures, use a .JPG or Tiff format only!

___ File Size: 3-12 MB

___ Label each file: Last Name, First Name – Title of Artwork (required if entering more than 1 image) –
School

Here is an example: **Smith, Lori – Sunset – Nampa High School.**

___ Prose File format: use Word, or PDF. Include your name and title of the prose at the top

___ **3. DIGITAL PRINT** -

___ Provide a high quality digital print no larger than 8 x 10.

___ Provide a **½ inch white border** around image for scoring purposes.

___ Write “top” on the backside of your artwork so it is viewed correctly when judging.

___ Attach a **YELLOW STICKY NOTE** to the back of the print including Last Name, First Name,
Title and School. Be careful not to damage the print in any way.

___ Provide a printed copy of any prose submissions

___ **4. READY TO SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY?** Place digital print or prose with the completed entry form in a clear
page protector, fronts facing outward. **TURN IN TO YOUR ART TEACHER.**

1. ___ **DIGITAL FILES:**

___ 1. Combine all your student entries on 1 CD. Label the disc: Art Source, School, & Teacher.

___ 2. Check file name: Last Name, First Name, Title, School

___ 3. Check that file sizes range from 3-12 MB in size.

___ 4. .JPG or .TIFF files only will be accepted. Please check your files, if you can't open it, we can't either!

2. ___ **DIGITAL PRINTS:** Please read the above information under STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS!

Prints will NOT be returned to you if specifications have not been made.

3. ___ **SUBMISSION PROCESS:** Please check that all students have completed the entry process with:

___ 2. High quality digital image w yellow sticky note with info. attached to the back.

___ 3. Readable digital file, .JPG or .TIFF.

___ 4. Entry form and digital image should be placed in clear protector sheet with fronts facing out.
